

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>COMPETITION RULES</b> <b>AYRSHIRE AUSTRALIA LTD - NELSON MANN/COLIN DAVIS</b> <b>ALL AUSTRALIAN PHOTO COMPETITION AND YOUTH PHOTO COMPETITION</b></p>

1. The All Australian Photo Competition is open to Ayrshire Cattle registered in the full Herd Book section, Appendix A & B and section R1.
2. Entries must be sent on an official entry form available from the Branch and Federal Secretaries **with the entry fee of \$5.50 (Inc GST) per photograph.**
3. Black & white or coloured photographs of females are eligible and must be at least 15cm x 10cm (6" x 4") but no larger than 20cm x 15cm (8" x 6") and must not be framed or bordered.
4. Only one photo per animal/group may be entered.
5. Photograph must be taken within 30 days of qualifying show, before or after, providing the animal stays in the same condition.
6. All entries must have been shown in an open class at any show in Australia in 2009.
7. Photographs must not contain any information front or back that identifies the owner.
8. Animals may be milking or dry in calf for Classes 2, 3, 4 & 5.
9. Where it is impractical to photograph an in calf heifer immediately prior to her calving in the attempt to enter her in Class 1 (under 2 yrs dry), she may be photographed after calving and will be eligible for entry into Class 2 (under 3 yrs in milk).
10. All entries must have on the top rear of photo written in felt pen:
  - year of entry
  - class entered
  - identification number (eg if you send in 3 entries they will be numbered by you 1-3)
11. Photos must be taken in the year of competition, be the correct size, not manipulated by computer imaging. Negatives must be supplied to the competition administrator, if requested.

### **Further information for Youth Photographic Competition**

- a. Age must be 18 years or under as at 31 December 2009.
- b. One entry per person per year.
- c. Heifer to be shown (led in class) by yourself but you don't necessarily need to own exhibit.
- d. Age of heifer:
  - If shown between Jan 1 - June 30, 2009, must be born after 31 December, 2006.
  - If shown between July 1 - Dec 31, 2009, must be born after 30 June, 2007.
- e. Heifer must be "dry" on date of show and photo of you holding her must be taken within 30 days of show while still dry.
- f. Heifer must have been shown in an open class at any show, including calf shows. The heifer is to have no ribbons/awards on her when photographed.
- g. Entry is free and winners will be published on the web site [www.lbcentre.com.au/](http://www.lbcentre.com.au/)
